

Frequently Asked Questions

The Rebel™ Self Retracting Lifeline (SRL) range is built to last providing an economical fall protection solution without compromising performance or safety.

1. What is the Rebel™ SRL range?

The new Rebel™ SRL range is a replacement for the retired JRG block range. The JRG workhorse range has been updated and modernised, and brought into the Rebel™ family to provide a more robust, compact and economical range of lifelines

2. What are the advantages of the new Rebel™ range compared to the old JRG range?

The new Rebel™ range has been completely updated and redesigned to include:

- Swivel anchorage connection
- Ergonomic carrying handle
- Ergonomic cable handle and bumper
- 16kN gate strength on all hooks/karabiners
- Choice of thermoplastic or aluminium housings
- Choice of galvanised or stainless steel cable
- Mining specific models (triple action karabiners)
- Sharp edge compliant (meets CE sharp edge certification requirements for horizontal use when used with an SRL shock absorbing unit, part no. Z6)
- Stackable housing design
- Bonus Servicing Voucher

3. What models are available?

The new Rebel™ range is available in 6, 10, 15, 20 and 30 metre lengths. The standard range is available in the following configuration: thermoplastic housing, galvanised cable lifeline, double action swivelling snap hook with fall indicator on lifeline and a connecting karabiner on housing. Optional aluminium housing and stainless steel cable models, and mining specific models featuring triple action karabiners are also available. The compact range is available in 3.3, 4.5 and 6 metre lengths and are available in both webbing and cable variants with a range of snap hook and karabiner end terminations on lifeline and connecting karabiner on housing. 4. Why are there different housing options?

Both housings are robust and durable to withstand the harshest operating environments. The heavy duty aluminium housing is the most durable due to its structural integrity, while the thermoplastic housing allows the block to be lightweight and still offer long lasting performance.

5. What applications/industries are the Rebel™ SRL's suited for?

The REBEL™ range can be used in a variety of industries and applications. This SRL is especially suited to the construction and industrial markets due to its robust and lightweight design. Typical applications include: commercial and residential construction, industrial maintenance, roofing applications, mining and resources, and many more.

6. How often do I have to service the Rebel™ SRL?

Capital Safety recommends that all Self Retracting Lifelines be serviced annually, however when used in harsh conditions, more frequent inspection may be required. To assist with your servicing programme each of the New Rebel™ SRL's are shipped with a Bonus Servicing Voucher that is valid for the lifelines first service - see Rebel™ brochure or visit www.rebel.capitalsafety.com.au for Terms and Conditions.

7. Does the Rebel™ range comply with all applicable standards and regulations?

Yes, the Rebel™ Self Retracting Lifeline range meets the requirements of EN 360 and conforms to 1891.3.
